Welcome and opening Alia Karaman, Chair, Centennial and Moore Park CTB	 The meeting was opened by the Chair. The Acknowledgement of Country was given. The Chair asked the group about alternating between online and face to face meetings. The majority were happy to alternate, although the preference was for meeting face to face. The Chair noted that the First Nations representative (Barbara Simms) will be resigning from the CTB. GSP will progress appointing a suitable representative once formal resignation is received. The appointment is subject to ministerial approval. 	1. GSP to progress appointing a new First Nations representative.
GSP Climate Adaptation Strategy overview David Kirkland, Senior Manager Environment, GSP	 GSP provided an overview of the Climate Adaptation Strategy (the Strategy) currently being prepared, focused on mitigating and responding to climate change across the parklands estate. GSP provided insight into specific actions related to environmental sustainability, biodiversity and land management at Centennial Park and Moore Park. Key climate-related risks for Centennial and Moore Park include increased variable rainfall, prolonged periods of hot and dry weather, and increased intensity of thunderstorm events. GSP provided an update on progress and next steps for developing the climate risk register and adaption action plan, which are key deliverables of the Strategy. GSP and the CTB discussed the key considerations and practical steps to mitigate climate risks in the short to medium term, including: noting erosion will be exacerbated by climate change whether the current flora will be suited to and how fauna will be protected in intense heat and a changing climate mitigation of algal blooms in ponds 	1. Update on proposed connection path at Mount Steel Trish Ferreira, Senior Manager Program Management, GSP	 GSP provided an update on the changes made to the planned Mount Steel connection path based on the feedback received from the CTB. GSP and the CTB discussed the following queries: are there plans to install lighting at the site consideration of providing access to Mount Steel through the golf course, noting the risk of pedestrians being hit by golf balls will GSP be taking measures to address erosion at the site. 	 GSP to consider ideas as part of ongoing development. GSP to provide response to question on erosion.
Update on Moore Park East Trish Ferreira, Senior Manager Program Management, GSP	 GSP provided an overview of the planned upgrades at Moore Park East following the legislated removal of event on grass car parking. GSP and the CTB discussed: sporting fields lighting funding for the Moore Park East works upgraded cricket wicket is up to standard legislation and timeline for on grass car parking removal procurement process further communication with the community about the planned upgrades. GSP provided an update on dogs at Moore Park East, noting that there will be no changes to the on- and off-leash areas at this stage. GSP and the CTB discussed: signage upgrades protection of wildlife including swans. 	GSP to consider ideas as part of ongoing development.
