Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to increase the limit on the number of events attracting large crowds for which Trust lands, other than Callan Park, may be used annually.

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1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Centennial Park and Moore Park Trust Amendment (Events) Regulation 2025*.
